### OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

*Genesis 41:41-49*

*God supplied Joseph, the Egyptians, and much of the Mediterranean world with an abundance of food to last them through the famine that was coming.*

<sup>41</sup>Pharaoh also said to Joseph, "Look, I have appointed you over the whole land of Egypt."

<sup>42</sup>Pharaoh took his signet ring off of his hand and put it on Joseph's hand. He dressed Joseph in robes made from the best linen and put a gold chain around his neck. <sup>43</sup>He had him ride in the second best chariot that he had. Men went ahead of him crying out, "Kneel down!" Pharaoh appointed him over the whole land of Egypt. <sup>44</sup>Pharaoh said to Joseph, "I am Pharaoh, but in the whole land of Egypt no one will lift up his hand or his foot without your permission." <sup>45</sup>Pharaoh gave Joseph the name Zaphenath Paneah, and he gave him Asenath, the daughter of Potiphara priest of On, as a wife. Joseph went out and began to rule over the land of Egypt.

<sup>46</sup>Joseph was thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh king of Egypt. Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh and traveled throughout the whole land of Egypt. <sup>47</sup>During the seven years of abundance the earth produced plentiful harvests. <sup>48</sup>He collected all the food during the seven good years in the land of Egypt, and he stored up the food in the cities. In every city he stored the food from the fields that were around the city. <sup>49</sup>Joseph stored up a huge amount of grain, like the sand of the sea. Finally he stopped keeping track, because it was too much to measure.

*Jesus shows the love of God as he gives health and food to people in need.*

<sup>13</sup>When Jesus heard this, he withdrew from there in a boat to a deserted place to be alone. When the crowds heard this, they followed him on foot from the towns.

<sup>14</sup>When Jesus got out of the boat, he saw a large crowd. He had compassion on them and healed their sick. <sup>15</sup>When evening came, his disciples came to him and said, "This is a deserted place and the hour is already late. Send the crowds away, so that they can go into the villages and buy food for themselves."

<sup>16</sup>But Jesus said to them, "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat."

<sup>17</sup>They told him, "We have here only five loaves and two fish."

<sup>18</sup>"Bring them here to me," he replied. <sup>19</sup>Then he instructed the people to sit down on the grass. He took the five loaves and the two fish. After looking up to heaven, he blessed them. He broke the loaves and gave them to the disciples. The disciples gave the food to the people. <sup>20</sup>They all ate and were filled. They picked up twelve basketfuls of what was left over from the broken pieces.

<sup>21</sup>Those who ate were about five thousand men, not even counting women and children.
